

MINUTES OF THE CITY OF HULL MAYOR AND COUNCIL

July 24, 2025

The meeting was called to order by Mayor John Barber at 7:00 p.m. at Hull City Hall. Those in attendance in addition to the Mayor were the Clerk, and council members Mike McElroy, Paige Phillips, and Steven Hollingsworth, and attorney Danny Love. Council member Yvonne Davenport was unable to attend due to a prior commitment.

A moment of silent prayer followed the pledge of allegiance.


The minutes of the June meeting were unanimously approved after a motion by Mike McElroy and a second by Paige Phillips. The financial reports were unanimously approved after a motion by Paige Phillips and a second by Steven Hollingsworth.

Under old business attorney Love reported that he had finally been able to have a long conversation with Mr. Pruitt, the County Attorney, concerning the intergovernmental agreements concerning zoning and building codes and attorney Love's opinion is that this is not a good time to pursue those agreements as the county is still in the process of reworking their zoning, etc. Attorney Love did advise Mayor and Council that we needed to set fees for Zoning and Building Permit fees. Attorney Love presented some recommended fees which are consistent with the county fees. After review a motion was made by Paige Phillips, seconded by Mike McElroy and unanimously approved to accept these recommended fees.

There was also some further discussion on what will be necessary for Adam Swann to receive approval to build the two homes he is interested in building on Glenn Carrie Road.. Mayor Barber and Attorney Love will get together and send a letter along with other information to him.

Under new business the Clerk presented the qualifying dates and times for the General Election to be held on November 4th for approval. Her recommendation is that Qualifying dates will be August 18-20 2025, from 6:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. The posts currently held by Mike McElroy and Steven Hollingsworth will be up for reelection. Motion was made by Paige Phillips, seconded by Steven Hollingsworth and unanimously approved to accept this recommendation.

There being no further business at this time the meeting was adjourned after a motion by Mike McElroy and a second by Paige Phillips.
