

MINUTES OF THE CITY OF HULL MAYOR AND COUNCIL

October 23, 2025

The meeting was called to order by Mayor John Barber at 7:00 p.m. at Hull City Hall. Those in attendance in addition to the Mayor were the Clerk, and council members Mike McElroy, Yvonne Davenport, Paige Phillips and Steven Hollingsworth, and attorney Danny . Mr. Lynn Shedd was also present.

A moment of silent prayer followed the pledge of allegiance.

The minutes of the September meeting were unanimously approved after a motion by Mike McElroy and a second by Steven Hollingsworth. The financial reports were unanimously approved after a motion by Yvonne Davenport and a second by Paige Phillips.

Under old business Attorney Love presented a draft of a revised Lease with the Fire Department. Mayor Barber will provide a copy to Chief Austin and the matter will be discussed again at the November meeting.


Attorney Love provided a proposed revised Fee List for review and consideration. This was unanimously approved after a motion by Paige Phillips and a second by Mike McElroy. The effective date will be October 23, 2025.

Under new business two Intergovernmental Agreements which had been presented to the City by the County Commission and reviewed by the Mayor, Clerk, and City Attorney were discussed. City Attorney Love explained both Agreements to Mayor and Council. He recommended that the City consider approving the agreement that provided for the establishment of a municipal court. A motion was made by Steven Hollingsworth, seconded by Yvonne Davenport and unanimously approved to enter into this Agreement with the County. Attorney Love will prepare a copy for signature at the November meeting. The Clerk will forward copies of both agreements to council members for review and further discussion at the November meeting.,

Mayor Barber then brought up for discussion the matter of purchasing additional Christmas decorations, when to decorate and when/if there was any interest in having an official tree lighting. After some discussion a motion was made by Paige Phillips to spend up to \$1,500.00 on additional decorations. The motion was seconded by Mike McElroy and unanimously approved. It was also decided that all that could would meet at 10:00 a.m. on November 22nd to decorate and that we would have a tree lighting on December 2nd at 6:30.

As a matter of information Mayor Barber advised that Angie's Place had been sold to Joe Alewine. Finally, Mr. Shedd was given permission to secure business cards and invoice the city for reimbursement.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned after a motion by Mike McElroy and a second by Steven Hollingsworth.

A moment of silent prayer followed the pledge of allegiance.


A motion was made by Yvonne Davenport, seconded by Paige Phillips and unanimously approved to enter into executive session to discuss pending litigation.
