

MINUTES OF THE CITY OF HULL MAYOR AND COUNCIL

April 23, 2026

The meeting was called to order by Mayor John Barber at 7:00 p.m. at Hull City Hall. Those in attendance in addition to the Mayor were the Clerk, and council members Mike McElroy, Yvonne Davenport, Paige Phillips and Steven Hollingsworth and Building Inspector, Lynn Shedd. Attorney Love was excused from the meeting...

A moment of silent prayer followed the pledge of allegiance.

The minutes of the March meeting were unanimously approved after a motion by Mike McElroy and a second by Steven Hollingsworth. The financial reports were unanimously approved after a motion by Paige Phillips and a second by Yvonne Davenport.

There was no old business.

Under new business Mayor Barber advised council that we needed to discuss how much money the City wanted to contribute to the County for the improvements being made to Old Elberton Road which are partially in the City., He advised that since we were current on our audits that we had received our LMIG and LARP funds which were about \$16,000.00. After some discuss a motion was made by Mike McElroy, seconded by Steven Hollingsworth and unanimously approved to contribute \$40,000.00 toward this project at this time. The Clerk will issue the check and Mayor Barber will deliver to the BOC.

The Clerk advised council that she would be out of town on the date of the June meeting and requested that the meeting date be changed. After some discussion a motion was made by Paige Phillips, seconded by Mike McElroy and unanimously approved to move the meeting to June 16, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. The Clerk will provide the proper notices.

There was some discussion about a zoning matter but no action was taken and the matter was tabled until the May meeting.

As a matter of information, Council member Davenport provided a web site for Mayor and Council to visit with respect to Christmas Decorations and Mayor Barber advised that he was meeting with someone next week to discuss and see what might be available to the City.

There being nothing further the meeting was adjourned after a motion by Mike McElroy and a second by Steven Hollingsworth.
