

Summary of July 24, 2025 Council Meeting

Mayor and Council met for its regular meeting on Thursday, July 24, 2025, at Hull City Hall. The Mayor and all council members were present with the exception of council member, Yvonne Davenport, who had a prior commitment, in addition to the Clerk and City Attorney.

The minutes and financial reports were approved as presented.

City Attorney Love gave an update on the Intergovernmental Agreements with the County that he had spoken at length with the County Attorney and did not feel like now was a good time to pursue the Intergovernmental Agreement with respect to Zoning and Building Codes. Attorney Love presented a recommendation for the Council's consideration with respect to Zoning and Building Permit Fees and Planning and Development Fees. This was approved.

There was continued discussion about the property on Glenn Carrie Road and what would need to be done for Adam Swann to receive approval for building two homes on the property. The Mayor and City Attorney will get together and put together some information to be sent to him.
