

## Summary of September 25, 2025 Council Meeting

Mayor and Council met for its regular meeting on Thursday, September 25, at Hull City Hall. The Mayor and all council members were present with the in addition to the Clerk and City Attorney. Also in attendance was Mr. Lynn Shedd.

The minutes and financial reports were approved as presented.

Mayor and Council voted to extend the contract for Green Scenez through January so that they would cut the crepe myrtles and clean up the curbs and sidewalks and trim all the shrubbery at the same rate as they are currently receiving per month.

Mayor and Council adopted the Ordinance to Amend the Code of the City of Hull to allow for the administration and enforcement of State Minimum Codes for Construction and Buildings and For Other Purposes. The Council also appointed Lynn Shedd as its Building Code Enforcement and Inspection Officer, Zoning Code Enforcement Officer and staff officer for the City of Hull Zoning Planning Commission and Ordinance Enforcement Office.

Voted to approve Letters of Engagement from McNair, McLemore Middlebrooks & Co. and authorized Clerk to sign for the preparation of the 2023 Agreed Upon Procedures.

Voted to extend the lease with the Hull Volunteer Fire Department for an additional 30 year period.

Voted to change the meeting dates for November and December due to Thanksgiving and Christmas
